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Dear Patient,

Your surgical procedure is scheduled at **New York Hospital Medical Center of Queens** located at the corner of **Booth Memorial Avenue and Main Street in Flushing, Queens**. Upon your arrival you are to take the elevator **down to the 1st floor** where the security guard will direct you to the admitting desk.

If pre surgical testing is to be performed by your primary doctor, it should be faxed to our office at least **4 days prior** to your procedure. These tests include: Blood work (CBC, PT, PTT, SMA 20), urinalysis, chest X-Ray, EKG, and a letter of medical clearance signed by your doctor.

If pre surgical testing is to be done at New York Hospital-Queens, an appointment will be arranged by our office. We will then call you to inform you of the date and time of the appointment. This pre surgical testing will be done at New York Hospital Medical Center. Upon arrival please take **elevator down to 1st floor and proceed to room #N150** for this pre-surgical testing.

- **DO NOT** EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIDNIGHT THE NIGHT BEFORE YOU PROCEDURE.
- **DO NOT** TAKE ASPRIN OR BLOOD THINNING RELATED PRODUCTS, WHICH INCLUDE: VITAMIN E, MOTRIN, OR IBUPROFEN, FOR 7 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE.
- IF YOU ARE TAKING ANY HEART MEDICATIONS PLEASE CONTACT YOUR PRIMARY DOCTOR.
- PLEASE ALSO CAREFULLY READ OUR DETAILED PRE-SURGICAL INSTRUCTIONS.
